#### We believe a Disciple Maker...

**Courageously stands for Truth**: Optional classes through Emmaus Bible College, Judson University, or Moody Bible Institute. A study of the Gospels and Discipleship training through the Scriptures.

**Humbly Serves**: Pathway Participants learn to serve within the ministry in various departments and take part in service projects.

**Has an Identity rooted in Christ:** Pathway Participants are expected to study about the Lord Jesus Christ as He is revealed through the Bible and align their identity in Him as described in 2 Corinthians 5:17.

**Equipped in heart and skill to share the Gospel**: Matthew 28:19a "Go therefore and make disciples..." Pathway exists to equip and train young adults to be disciples who make disciples like Jesus.

**Faithful to God and others:** Be present to obtain a clear understanding of excellence in work, relationships, and service. Observing and absorbing scripture together daily.


