Free // Located in the field behind the Carrerra Welcome Center. Gather a group of 3 to ride 75ft to the top. Pull the rip cord at the top to initiate your adventure!

Zipline

Free // Located behind the Cabin Circles. Climb to the top of our Zip Tour and jump off for the ride of a lifetime!

Climbing Wall

Free // Located in the Ceylon Court Gym Climb one of 6 different routes of varying difficulty.

Slip N Slide

Free // Located behind the Humphrey House Slide down Humphrey Hill in a cloud of soapy suds!

Archery

Free // Located at the bottom of Humphrey Hill Test your marksmanship as you let arrows loose at the range.

Archery Tag

Free // Look for Location Communication Engage in a tactical challenge against your fellow campers, firing foam tipped arrows to get them out.

Crate Stacking

Free // Outside the Bathhouse Can your cabin make the tallest crate stack this summer? Test your hand at crate stacking to find out.

Nature Center

Free // Located in the Nature Center Learn the natural sciences and visit our petting zoo.

Handcraft

Free and Paid Activities Available //
Located in the Handcraft Center
Try your hand at fun crafts and make somethings to take home.

Paintball

Paid // Located at the south end of Activity Field 2 Engage in a tactical challenge against your fellow campers. For Campers aged 10 and Up Only

Gellyball

Paid // Located in Activity Field 2 in the paintball field.
Engage in a tactical challenge against your fellow campers, but with pellets that hurt less than paintballs! For Boys & Girls Camp Only

Paid // Waterfront

At 6 AM for Boys & Girls Campers, at 7AM for Jr High Campers. Ride the waves of Geneva Lake as an extreme sport experience.

OUR PHILOSOPHY BEHIND RECREATION

Above all, our desire is that recreation is simply another tool for bringing your students into a living, meaningful relationship with Jesus Christ. It is an opportunity for your students to bond together and for walls to break down, allowing trust and friendships to be built. Hopefully, this trust and friendship will translate into enriching conversations in your breakout sessions and cabin times.

BE INTENTIONAL WITH RECREATION

Encourage Your Students To Get Involved. If you do not want to participate or have a bad attitude, they will follow you. Whether you win or lose, remember the point is to have fun and to build unity within your group.

Be Respectful. It is easy to get a little too competitive, even as cabin leaders. Remember, these students are watching you!! If you are yelling at the refs or being rude to the other teams, it can just turn ugly. Show your students what it looks like to be competitive with integrity.

Dress Appropriately. We ask all campers and Cabin Leaders—guys and girls—to dress in a way that reflects modesty and respect. Whether you're playing games like Broom Hockey, hanging out at the waterfront, or just walking around camp, make sure your clothing allows you to move freely without revealing anything that shouldn't be seen.

Let's work together to keep camp a place where we honor Christ first and show respect to each other in how we dress and carry ourselves.

PATCH PROGRAM

GROWING CAMPERS INTO GOSPEL SERVANTS

At Lake Geneva Youth Camp, we believe following Jesus means more than just attending church or participating in Christian activities—it means becoming a servant of the Gospel. Our Patch Program helps campers take that step. It's designed to move them from simply consuming Christian things to actively living out their faith with purpose.

Each summer, campers earn patches that represent both spiritual growth and personal challenge. These aren't just souvenirs—they're markers of a life that is being shaped into the image of Christ.

HOW IT WORKS

Every camper receives a Patch Card during their week at camp. They'll work toward patches in the following areas:

- Spiritual Growth Memorizing Scripture, sharing their testimony, praying for others
- Personal Responsibility Keeping their cabin clean, showing respect to leaders
- Serving Others Looking for ways to help teammates, showing kindness
- Adventure Challenges Trying something new, completing outdoor activities

At the end of the week, campers are awarded their earned patches during a special ceremony—a powerful moment of encouragement and celebration.

WHY IT MATTERS

The Patch Program reminds campers that following Jesus is a journey of growth. Each patch is a small but meaningful step toward becoming a Gospel-centered servant who lives with intention, courage, and faith.
